I. Program Objectives

1. General Objectives

The Master's degree program in Civil Law and Civil Procedure Law at Ho Chi Minh City University of Law is oriented towards research and application. Its main goal is to train a team of legal master's graduates with in-depth knowledge of Vietnamese law (including comparisons with international and foreign laws in the field of civil law), a clear understanding of legal issues in civil law, and the ability to contribute to the construction of the socialist rule of law in Vietnam, ensuring justice in the field of judicial practice.

2. Specific Objectives

The specific objectives of the Master's degree program in Civil Law and Civil Procedure Law are to train law graduates (LLM) who:

- PO1.** Demonstrate respect for and protection of the law;
- PO2.** Possess in-depth and extensive expertise in civil law;
- PO3.** Analyze and assess legal issues accurately in the field of civil law;
- PO4.** Independently apply legal principles to real-life situations in the field of civil law;
- PO5.** Exhibit professional ethics and a sense of community service in tasks related to civil law;
- PO6.** Have the ability for lifelong learning and scientific research.

II. Graduation standards

- PLO1.** Possess deep and broad practical and theoretical knowledge of the fundamentals in the field of civil law;
- PLO2.** Acquire knowledge of scientific research methods and develop solutions to overcome limitations and obstacles in theoretical, legal, and practical applications of civil law;
